The Secretariat Meeting of the ITEF was held on 4th September, 2018 at Manishinath Bhawan, New Delhi. The meeting was presided over by Com. Ravindran Nair, President. All the Secretariat members except Comrades Y Purohit, R Meena, Suresh Nair, S Mukherjee and Usha Bonepally were present in the meeting.

One minutes silence was observed in memory of Com. Somnath Chatterjee, former Speaker, Lok Sabha, Shri. Atal Bihari Vajpayee, former Prime Minister, Shri. M.Karunanithi, former Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu and other people who died in Natural calamity at Kerala. Before going into agenda Com. President appealed all the members of Secretariat to contribute generously for the relief work of Kerala. Com. Secretary General also requested all the Circles to donate as much as possible to the Chief Minister Relief Fund directly or send cheque/draft to the account of Kerala Circle as per appeal of ITEF and intimate the details of Contribution made to CHQ. immediately.

Com. Secretary General informed the house about the developments on issues since the decision of suspension of the agitation programme. He also informed about the discussion in the meeting with the Member (Admin) on 23rd August, 2018 and assurance has given by the Chairman, CBDT in the Managing Committee meeting of ITGOA on 19th August at Civic Centre, New Delhi, to resolve the issues especially concerning the members of ITEF.

The following pending issues were explained by secretary General:

1. The pending Recruitment Rules of Inspector and Executive Assistant, the DoPT returned both the files with same objections. The RR issue will be discussed in the CWC meeting to decide further course of action.
2. ITO to ACIT promotion order already issued. But till now the DPC for promotion to AD(OL) has not taken place.
3. The issue of relaxation for promotion is under active consideration and the issue will be pursued on a priority basis.
4. Regarding Staff Car Driver issues, all Circle General Secretaries are requested to meet with all SCDs in the respective regions and to send suggestions before 30th Sept.2018 for discussion in the ensuing CWC meeting and to finalise new proposal.
5. For payment under wages head directly from the Cadre Controlling Authorities to the Casual Workers, it is proposed by the HRD to withdraw the circular issued on 13th May 2013 by the CIT (V & L) of CBDT and a direction will be issued shortly to pay the minimum wage as per 7th CPC.
6. Regarding pay fixation of Inspector to Rs.7450 from 1.1.2006, as per advice of the DoE and DoLA, the Department will file Appeal before Principal CAT Delhi instead of Writ Petition in the High Court within a short period of time.
7. Cadre Review Committee will be formed by including our representative shortly.
8. For promotion to the post of Tax Assistant, a further instruction will be issued by HRD for uniform application/implementation.
9. Regarding new policy for Inter Charge Transfer, the report of the committee submitted before the CBDT for finalisation.

10. For temporary allocation of ITI Post in the regions where stagnation is acute, a committee was formed, but no meeting was taken place. The Pr.DG(HRD) was requested to convene a meeting as early as possible to settle it.

The Secretary General proposed to allow the Board some more time in the light of discussion with the new Member (Admin), CBDT, where he had requested for settling down and looking into all the pending issues. It was also proposed to wait till the CWC meeting which is going to be held on 1-2nd October, 2018, so that the progress till then could be reviewed in the Meeting and the decisions taken there could thereafter be discussed in Central JCA to determine the future course of action. After threadbare discussions, the ITEF Secretariat unanimously accepted the proposal regarding extension of the suspended agitation program up to next CWC.

Com.KKN Kutty the president of Confederation updated the meetings of NJCA, JCM Staff Side and National Anomaly Committee took place after the Hyderabad Convention. He also briefed about the importance of agitation program on 10 point charter of demands. The following decisions taken in various forum were also informed in the house.

1. NJCA will observe 19th September as demands day by holding lunch hour demonstration.
2. All Trade Union Convention will be held on 28th September at Delhi and according to the decision of the convention the 15th November Strike will be modified.

Agenda No. 3.

- i) Com.Vinod informed that CWC Meeting is arranged at the International Centre of Goa, Dr.E.Borgs Road, Dona Pawla, Goa-403 004 on 1st and 2nd October.
- ii) It was decided to restrict to the Presidents and Secretaries of Circles, equivalent alternates to Secretariat members as an observer, Auditor, Chairman of Election

- Commission, women delegates (permanent invitees of CWC), erstwhile Gr. D Circle Secretaries or Presidents (where merger was taken place) and senior leaders as per notice of the CWC meeting already issued. No other observers will be allowed in the ensuing CWC meeting.
- iii) It was further reiterated to donate an amount of Rs.10000/ to host circle by each circles for organising CWC meeting smoothly.
 - iv) Regarding recognition of ITEF, the file has sent to the CBDT for approval. It was decided to carry out the membership verification process, where it is not completed.
 - v) Merger of Gr D Circles - Only Delhi, Nagpur, AP and UP West Gr D circles are yet to be merged. All circle Secretaries of above mentioned circles are requested to discuss again with the leaders of erstwhile Gr.D circles for merger. The CBDT rejected the proposal to form the MTS Circle for recognition.

Payment of Dues – Com. President appealed before the house to make payment of Renewal Fees, Aayakar subscription, Legal Fees, Organisation Fund and Building Maintenance Fund immediately.

 - c) The MACP issues is required to be sorted out as early as possible.

 - e) Relaxation in skill test to appear Ministerial Exam for sports persons.
 - f) Decision about Existing Election commission in CWC
 - g) Departmental Examination 2018- Question pattern in ITO/ITI exam and out of syllabus ijn Paper IV in Ministerial Staff
 - h) Circular of Member (p) on Vigilance Matter.
 - i) To remove 10 chances in the Departmental exam
