- G.S.R. 380.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, the President branchy makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Stenographer Grade-1 in the Ministry of Finance, Income -Tax Department, namely:—
- 1. Short title and Commencement.—(1) These rides may be called the Ministry of Finance, Income-Tax Department Stenographer Grade-I Group 'B' non-gazetted post Recruitment Rules, 2005.
 - (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
- 2. Number of Posts, Classification and Scale of Pay.—The number of posts, its classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule numexed to these rules.
- 3. Method of Recruitment, age limit, and other qualifications etc.—The method of recruitment, age limit, educational, qualifications and other matters relating to the said post shall be as specified in columns (5) to (14) of the said Schedule.
- 4. Initial Constitution.—(1) The incumbents of the post of Stenographer Grade-Lappointed on regular basis vide Office Order Number A 12018/7/91-AD.VII, dated the 16th August, 1991 shall be deemed to have been appointed under the Provisions of thase rules. (2) the service rendered by them in the post of regular basis before the publication of these rules shall be taken into account for deciding the eligibility for promotion to the next higher post and for the purpose of pensionary benefits.
 - 5. Disqualifications.—No person,---
 - (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
- (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to any of the said posts:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is percussible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any persons from the operation of this rule.

- 6. Power to relax.—Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.
- 7. Saving.—Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Ex-Servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time, in this regard.
